CODELCO CHUQUICAMATA DIVISION is an open pit and underground copper and gold mine, located 15 km north of Calama, in the Antofagasta Region. It is considered the largest of its kind in the world and is currently undergoing a major transformation process. Products: electro-refined cathodes and cathodes obtained through electrowinning, and copper concentrate.
