



VISIT TO MINE SITE: SCM EL ABRA

DATE: Thursday 06 June 2024

Minera El Abra, a subsidiary of Freeport-McMoran, is an open pit copper mining site located 76 km northeast of the city of Calama. It has been operating since 1996 and mainly produces copper cathodes. In terms of ownership, 51% belongs to Freeport-McMoran and the other 49% belongs to Codelco.
