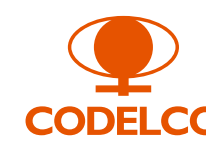

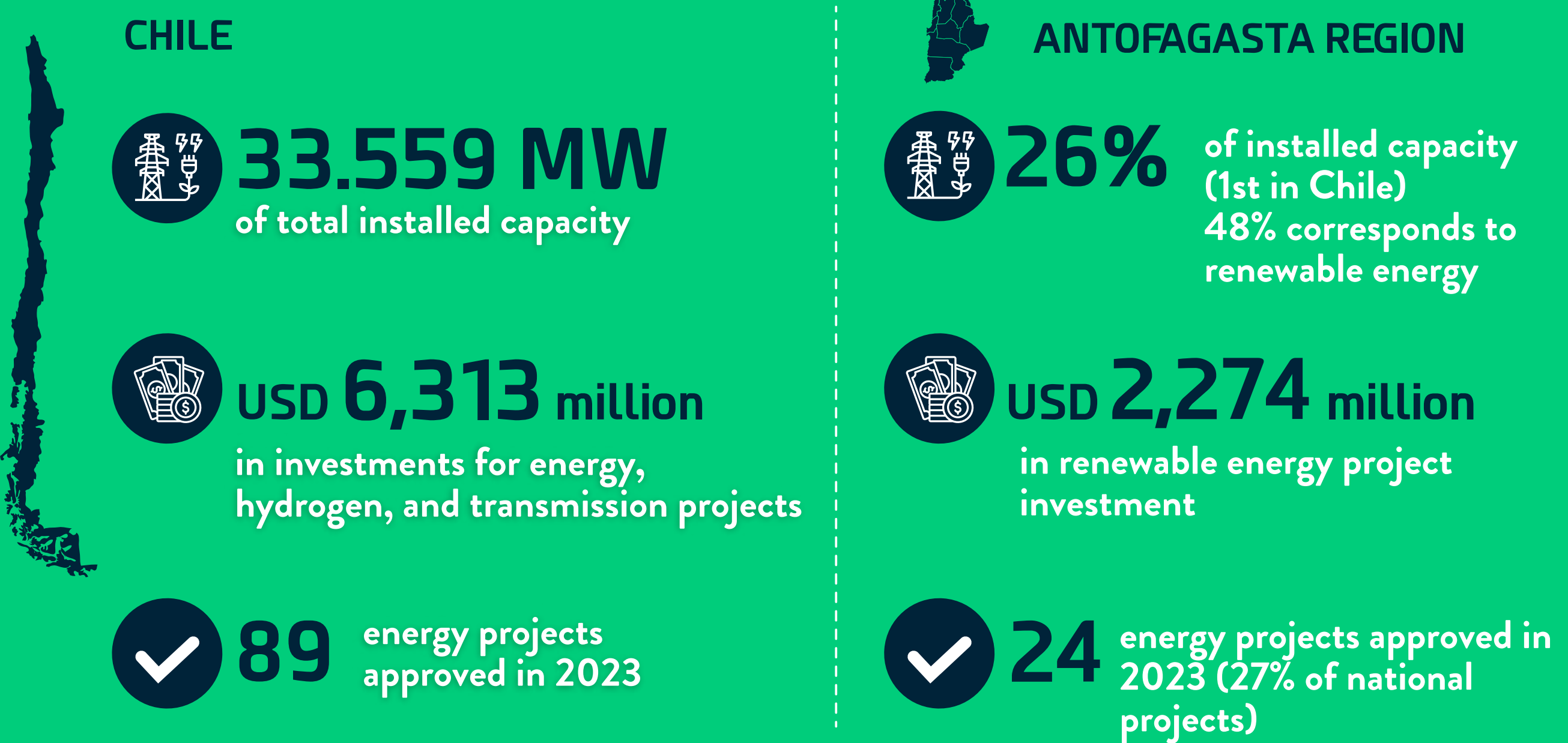

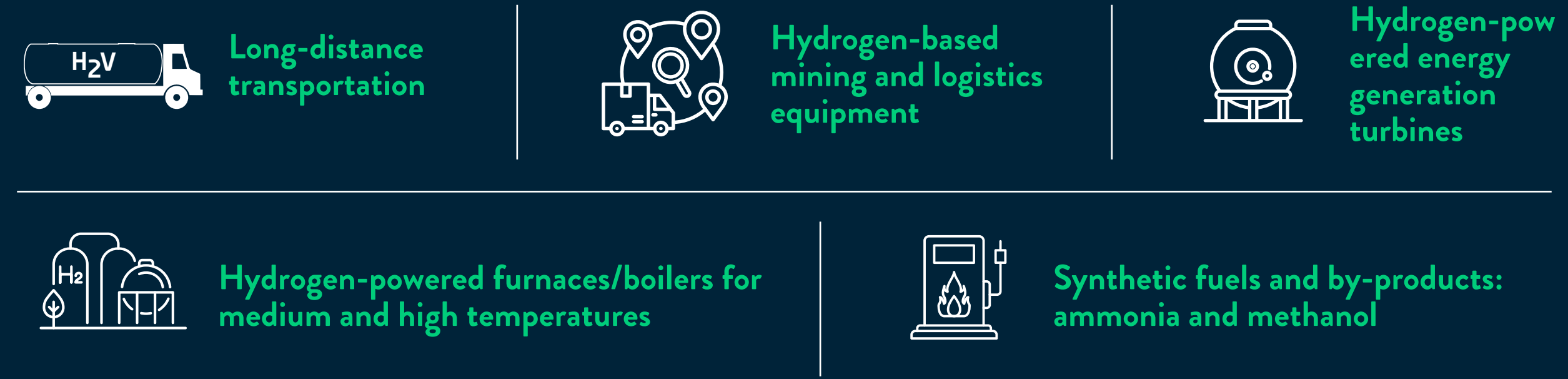


Green hydrogen

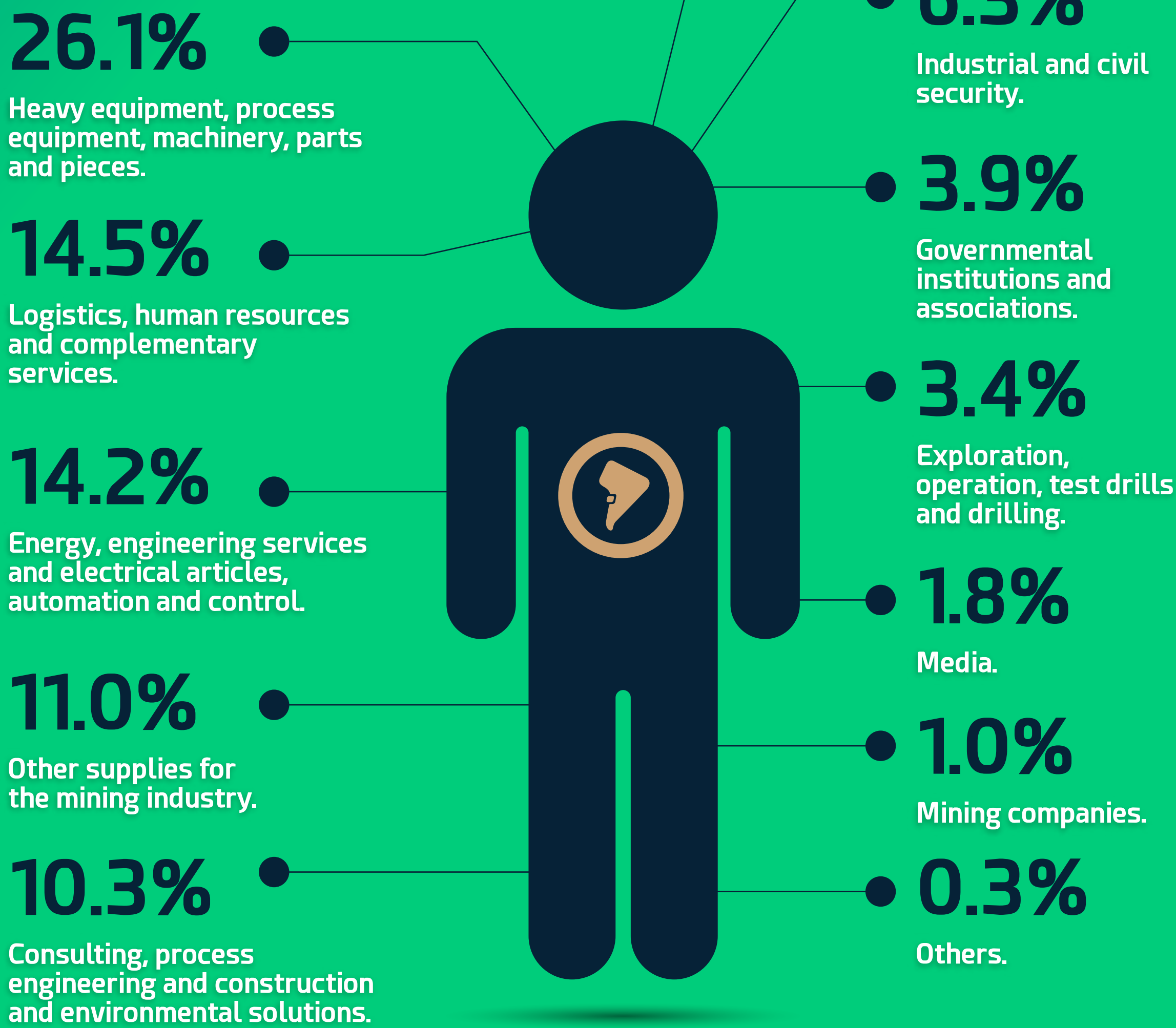

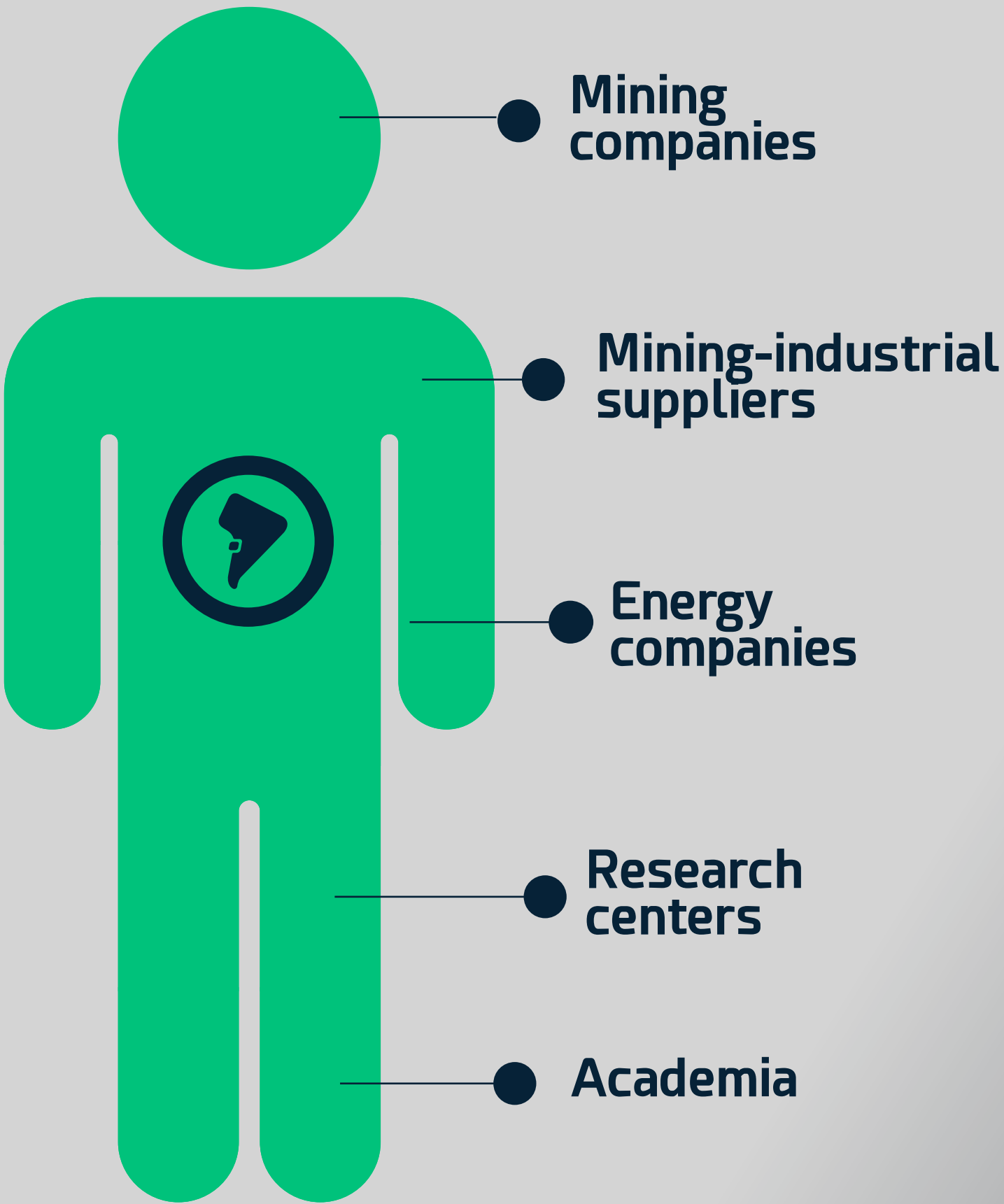

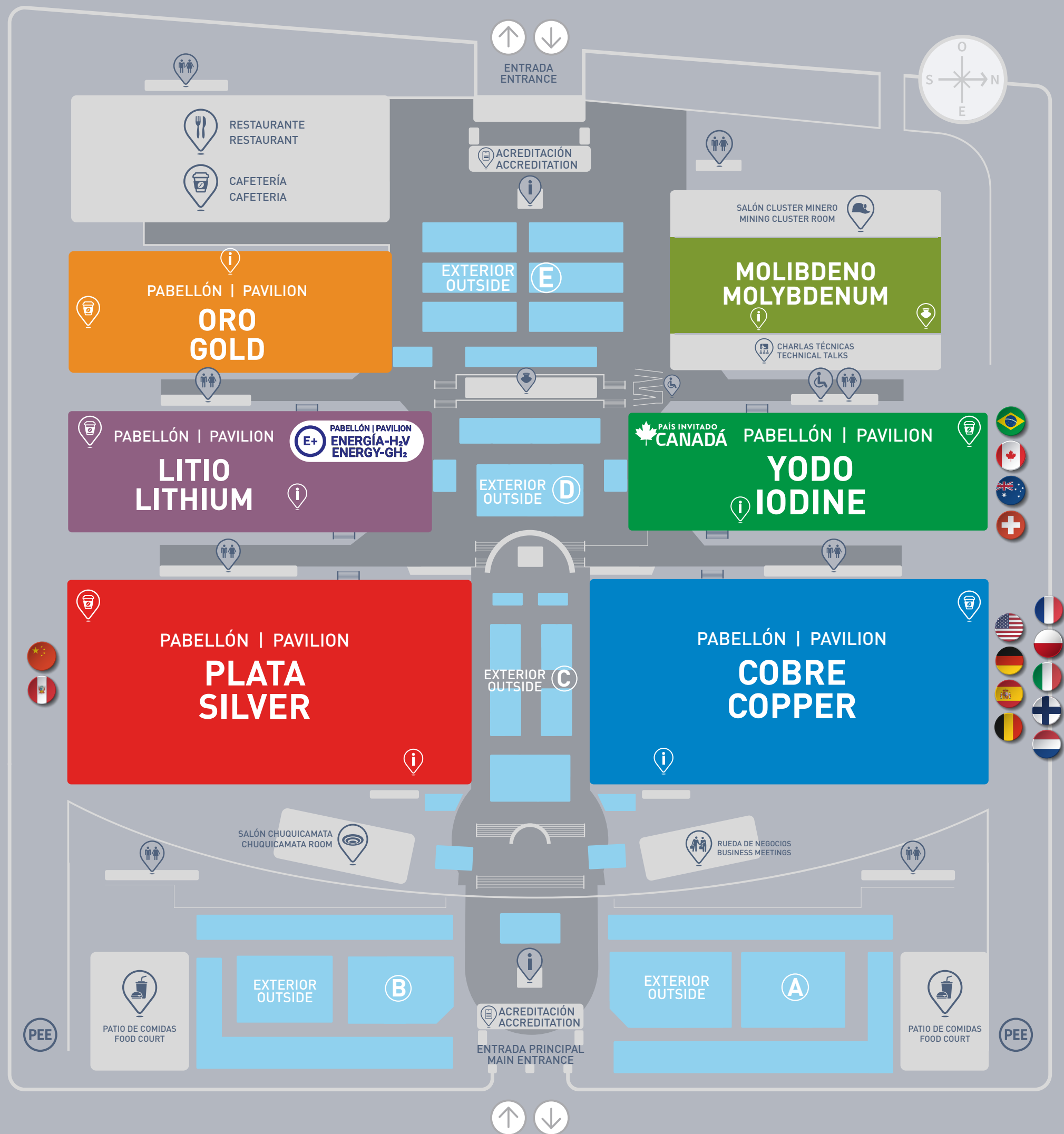
