CODELCO, CHIQUICAMATA DIVISION is an open-pit and underground copper and gold mine, located 15 km north of Calama, in the Antofagasta Region. It is considered the largest of its kind in the world and is currently undergoing a major transformation process. Products: electro-refined and electrowon cathodes, and copper concentrate.

- **Start of operations:** May 18, 1915
- **Distance from Antofagasta:** 217 km.
- **Deposit height:** 2,800 m.a.s.l.
- **Production Level:** ~ 265,000 metric tons of fine copper
- **Staff (not including contractors):** 3,939
