**Mina El Peñón** is an underground gold and silver mine located in the Antofagasta Region. It produces doré bars using a metallurgical process that combines leaching with the Merrill-Crowe method.

The operation has been in production since 1999 and is characterized by its high-grade epithermal vein system. The plant processes approximately 3,600 tons of ore per day, with combined gold and silver production.

The mine is currently operated by Pan American Silver, a Canadian mining company with operations in the Americas.

- **Start of operations:** 1999
- **Distance from Antofagasta:** 160 km.
- **Deposit height:** ~ 1,700 - 1,740 m.a.s.l.
- **Production Level:**
  - **Annual Gold Production:** 115.2 koz
  - **Annual Silver Production:** 3.9 Moz
- **Staff:** 1,468 workers and 760 collaborators.
