Novandino Litio's Carmen Lithium Chemical Plant began operations in 1996 with an annual production capacity of 25,000 tons.

Today, it produces 210,000 metric tons of lithium carbonate equivalent (LCE), and we can proudly say that Chile has the largest lithium carbonate and hydroxide refining plant on the planet.

- **Start of operations:** 1996
- **Distance from Antofagasta:** 20 km
- **Deposit altitude:** 500 m
- **Production Level:** 210,000 metric tons.
- **Staff (not including contractors):** 1,100 workers.
